Intent


All pupils will engage in daily acts of collective worship that enhance their understanding of the world around them. Through discussing and exploring religious ideas, beliefs and festivals alongside secular issues that permeate society and culture they will recognise that all beliefs, all questions and all views are valid.

Implementation

During Monday assembly a Thought for the Week is introduced. This is usually through a short video message:



Pupils discuss this thought every day in class before feeding back their thoughts during assembly on Friday.





Impact

Through 'Thought of the Week' pupils at Winchelsea are gaining knowledge of religious concepts which are also linked to social, moral, spiritual and cultural themes. This is helping pupils to develop their understanding in both these areas. "We talked about how Eve made an unhelpful choice in the Garden of Eden. By eating the apple she broke God's trust."
